1. From the homepage, click on the “Maps & Data” **Maps & Data** tab then select “Build a Report.”

How to Get Started?

1. Select the report area of interest. The report area can be defined by County, and/or Custom (where you may select from existing geographies such as city or ZIP Code.). Note: [Population-weighted small area estimate](#) method will be used to summarize data for custom report areas.
2. Once you have selected the report area, you may choose to save it for future reference by clicking the “Save Report Area” button.

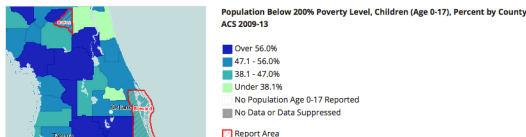
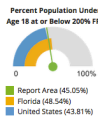
5. Limit your indicators or find those that aren’t meeting state benchmarks by clicking the “Customize Report” button.

Poverty - Children Below 200% FPL

In the report area 45.05% or 49,362 children are living in households with income below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). This indicator is relevant because poverty creates barriers to access including health services, healthy food, and other necessities that contribute to poor health status.
