
Participatory budgeting

is a democratic process in which community members directly decide how to spend part of a public budget.





Where PB is happening




What kind of budgets?


- City, county, state budgets

- Federal funds (e.g. Community Development Block Grants)
- Housing authority or other public agency budgets
- School, school district, university budgets
- Community Benefit Agreements
- Tax Increment Financing (TIF)
- Non-governmental sources like foundation or non-profit budgets





County Health Rankings for Greensboro, NC & area


