## Tour Stop Descriptions

### 1 LaPierre Lane Riverway

*LaPierre Lane, Morrisonville, NY 12962*

The LaPierre Lane Riverway is a branch of the Saranac River Trail Greenway. The greenway is a 27-mile trail concept extending from the City of Plattsburgh, through the towns of Plattsburgh, Schuyler Falls and Saranac. The riverway project is the result of a partnership between the Foundation of CVPH Medical Center, the Town of Plattsburgh, and the New York State Health Foundation. It offers a variety of opportunities for multi-generational physical activity.

### 2 West Chazy Park

*7658 NY-22, West Chazy, NY 12992*

In 2017, the Healthy Neighborhood Initiative began working with the resident-led West Chazy Park Revitalization Committee on an extensive project to reverse the deteriorated condition of the park. The goal of this project is to redevelop the park to offer multigenerational and all-ability inclusive opportunities. The full execution of the revitalization will result in a community gathering place that offers something for everyone, from playgrounds and ball fields to “pickleball” courts and an accessible 0.75-mile walking path.

### 3 Cumberland Bay Market

*1544 Cumberland Head Rd, Plattsburgh, NY 12901*

Cumberland Bay Market is one of 13 Clinton County Better Choice Retailers. Better Choice Retailers are small, locally-owned convenience stores that fill a gap, allowing residents to purchase food nearby. Clinton County Health Department (CCHD) works with prospective Better Choice Retailers to help them meet program standards and offer healthier options. Cumberland Bay Market has recently been renovated, and will soon offer an outdoor produce stand for customers to access fresh fruits and vegetables close to home.

### 4 Plattsburgh Farmers' and Crafters' Market

*Durkee St, Plattsburgh, NY 12901*

The Plattsburgh Farmers' and Crafters' Market was established in June 2005. It is the largest farmers' market in Clinton County and is located on Durkee Street in downtown Plattsburgh. CCHD has worked with the market to ensure that SNAP and farmers' market coupons are accepted. CCHD also helped the market apply as a vendor for the Double Up Food Bucks program, which doubles SNAP benefits spent at participating markets.

### 5 Valcour Inn Boathouse

*3712 U.S. 9, Peru, NY 12972*

Valcour Inn and Boathouse is a unique venue in the region. Located on the western shore of Lake Champlain, it is owned and managed by SUNY Plattsburgh's College Auxiliary Services. Valcour offers panoramic views of the Green Mountains of Vermont and overlooks Valcour Island, the site of one of the most historic battles of the Revolutionary War.
