Why Economic Health Matters for Socially Connected Communities March 2024

The Issue

Our skills, labor (paid and unpaid), spending, volunteering, exchanges, contributions, innovation, votes, and advocacy truly power our economy and the thriving families and communities we desire. It's vital that we see how a wellbeing economy supports economic health and socially connected communities.

Webinar Summary & Highlights

Subject matter experts, Elizabeth Garlow, Senior Fellow at New America, and Amanda Janoo, Economics & Policy Lead at Wellbeing Alliance, discussed a wellbeing economy which offers a new paradigm for community health leaders and is an important part of a socially connected community.

- The **Five Core Principles of a wellbeing economy** are fairness, nature, participation, dignity, and connection. Mutual aid, volunteering, gift-based exchange, and indigenous economies are examples of local strategies that help strengthen social connection.
- Shared prosperity will not happen in a divided economy with growing wage and job inequalities. Instead, we need to embrace new values that are responsive to our needs and voices, including community and connection.
- Expressions of **democratic ownership and governance** are deeply tied with enhancing social connection.
- "Commoning" is a term to describe resources held in common like community spaces for gathering and the act of caring for them together. This practice could help support a gift- and care-based economy that can strengthen social health.
